

Our Kindergarten Day

<i>Activity</i>	<i>We are learning...</i>
Attendance/Morning Business	<i>Students will be practicing following daily routines and procedures.</i>
Calendar/Math	<i>We learn math and language skills in context of our calendar. During math the teacher will provide lessons to the whole group. Students will then practice these particular skills with a partner and again individually. New skills are introduced during this period.</i>
Phonemic Awareness	<i>Students will participate in activities focused on phonics/phonemic awareness such as rhyming, segmenting, blending.</i>
Shared Reading	<i>This is an interactive reading activity where students join in or share the reading of a poem, book or other text.</i>
Guided Reading & Centers	<i>This is a chance for the teacher to pull small reading groups and to provide reading instruction at each student's individual ability. The students not meeting with the teacher will be practicing literacy skills individually or with a partner.</i>
Writing	<i>The teacher will provide writing lessons that will guide the students as they make meaning in their illustrations and writing composition. Students write on a topic of their own choice or to a prompt.</i>
Specials	<i>Students will attend special classes on a rotating basis (P.E., Art and Music)</i>
Read Aloud	<i>The teacher will read a story aloud to the group focusing on a specific purpose (vocabulary, parts of a book, fluency, type of text, etc)</i>

Science and Social Studies content will be integrated throughout the curriculum.
